SAME ANNUAL COMMUNITY-WIDE EVENT: Sunday, July 28th, 7:00 pm, at Young Israel, featuring Rabbi Dr. Ari Sytner. Rabbi Dr. Sytner is a licensed social worker and couples therapist with a private practice in Teaneck. He is a professor at Yeshiva University's Wurzweiler School of Social Work, the author of "The Kidney Donor's Journey", and the director of leadership and community development for Yeshiva University's Center for the Jewish Future. He provides trauma intervention for Chai Lifeline, frequently lectures for Shalom Task Force, and speaks extensively about dating, marriage, and divorce, sharing his unique doctoral research on challenges within the Orthodox community. He was a pulpit rabbi for 13 years in Iowa and South Carolina and currently lives in Bergenfield, NJ with his wife, Chana and their four children.
