GUESTS: Please note that seating capacity is very limited. At present, we cannot accommodate out-of-town guests until we see how the capacity fills in. If we have the space, we will certainly welcome guests, but not at this time.

CHILDREN: Please also be aware that unfortunately we cannot accommodate children's programming. You all know my feelings about the importance of children in shul. However, these are exceptional circumstances. Due to social distancing, spacing and mask wearing requirements, we can only accommodate children who are old enough to sit in shul through the davening and participate. Please do not plan on bringing younger children to shul. We daven every day that we will soon be able to reopen for children as well, as that is our pride and joy!

SINGING: We will have low-key congregational style singing at the indoor minyan.

SHOFAR: During the indoor minyan on RH, the Ba'al Tokeah will be standing outside the building at one of the doors that open to the sanctuary (social hall or east door).

AFTERNOON SHOFAR BLOWING: There will be a series of Shofar blowing throughout the neighborhood (outdoors). We will publicize times and venues. We can also organize private shofar blowing for individuals who cannot access any of these venues. More information will be forthcoming in the coming days and weeks.
