Rabbi Steven Weil is the Senior Managing Director of the Orthodox Union. Rabbi Weil studied at Yeshivat Kerem B'Yavneh and Yeshiva University, from which he received his ordination. He also holds an M.B.A. from NYU's Stern School of Business. Rabbi Weil successfully led the Young Israel of Oak Park, Michigan followed by Beth Jacob Congregation in Beverly Hills, California; significantly expanding synagogue membership and programming in both. In 2009 he began working for the Orthodox Union, where he now serves as Senior Managing Director. Rabbi Weil is a passionate advocate for Israel and for Jewish education. He is a renowned speaker and has served internationally as scholar-in-residence and has delivered invocations for former President Bush, Governor Schwarzenegger, Speaker John Boehner and the House of Representatives among others.
