The FOUNDATIONAL CENTRALITY of the MITZVAH of TALMUD TORAH

Rabbi Rosensweig occupies the Nathan and Perel Schupf Chair in Talmud at RIETS (YU), is a rosh yeshiva in the Mazer Yeshiva Program (YU), and is rosh kollel of the prestigious Israel Henry Beren Institute for Higher Talmudic Studies (RIETS). He received his semikha from RIETS, was a distinguished fellow of its post-semikha institute (Gruss Kollel Elyon), received his BA from Yeshiva College and earned his PhD in medieval Jewish history from the Bernard Revel Graduate School of Jewish Studies. He studied under Professor Haym Soloveitchik, and was also a student of Rav Aharon Lichtenstein z"l. He has written extensively and is known for his intricate conceptual approach to Talmud study, as well as his heavy use of Brisker methodology in Talmudic analysis.
